The Housing Authority of the City of Passaic announces the 45-day public review and comment period relating to a new Emergency Transfer Policy for Victims of Domestic Violence, Dating Violence, Sexual Assault, or Stalking in accordance with the Violence Against Women Act (VAWA) and U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Regulations (24 CFR Part 5, Subpart L).
